ECC has 125 members across the UK: from Aberdeen to Cornwall, from Belfast to East Anglia.

Since their introduction in 2002, our HERA and FEDRA schemes have analysed more than 150,000 roles within 130 organisations – representing at least 500,000 staff.

And although there is of course more work to do, we're very proud that ECC members' mean gender pay gap (14.2%) was smaller than non-members (16.6%)¹. That's why it has never been so important to have a robust, sector-specific approach to job evaluation and role analysis.
